

RESOLUTION No. 236

A RESOLUTION SELECTING AN ALIGNMENT FOR THE EXTENSION OF 257th AVENUE (KANE ROAD) AND CALLING FOR THE COMPLETION OF A CENTERLINE SURVEY.

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Plan for the City of Troutdale has, as a general goal "To provide a safe and co-ordinated transportation and circulation system that will bring about the best relationships between places where people live, work and play" and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Plan further stated that 257th Avenue should be extended north of Cherry Park Road to accomodate future traffic needs, and

WHEREAS, the specifics of this alignment were to be resolved at a future time, and

WHEREAS, the Functional Classification system developed in a co-operative effort by the East County cities and Multnomah County designates 257th Avenue as a major north/south arterial, and

WHEREAS, a special study of 257th Avenue has now been completed which recommends a specific alignment of 257th Avenue extension, shown as Alternative #3 on the map attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and

WHEREAS, the Troutdale Planning Commission has reviewed the study and has recommended Alternative No. 3, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to establish a specific centerline for the proposed alignment in order to preserve the necessary right-of-way as development occurs.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Troutdale that 257th Avenue be extended north from Cherry Park Road to Graham Road, shown as Alternative No. 3 on Exhibit "A" attached and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council directs the City staff to prepare a centerline survey report for presentation to the Council at a later date.


