

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING CERTAIN STREETS AND ROADS WITHIN THE CITY OF TROUTDALE AS TRUCK ROUTES.

WHEREAS, ORS 483.542 authorizes the City of Troutdale to designate any street, road or highway, or section thereof as a truck route and to prohibit the operation of trucks, machinery or any other large or heavy vehicles upon any street, road or highway which serves the same route or area served by the said truck route, and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Troutdale finds that certain roads and streets within the City of Troutdale have experienced or are very likely to experience deterioration and damage under use by heavy vehicles,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, THAT:

1. The Common Council of the City of Troutdale finds that the following road or street between the points designated below should be and is hereby closed to vehicles having a gross weight in excess of six tons:

S.E. Sandy Street from the intersection with Troutdale Road and Cherry Park Road to S.E. 3rd Street then, S.E. 3rd from S.E. 3rd and S.E. Sandy to S.E. 3rd and S.E. Dora Street then, S.E. Dora Street from S.E. 3rd and S.E. Dora Street to S.E. Dora Street and E. Columbia Highway.

2. All trucks or other vehicles having a gross weight in excess of six tons shall use the following streets and roads through the City of Troutdale:

Cherry Park Road from the intersection of Troutdale Road, S.E. Sandy Street and Cherry Park Road to S.E. Buxton Street and Cherry Park Road. Then S.E. Buxton Street from the intersection of Cherry Park Road and S.E. Buxton Street to S.E. Buxton Street and E. Columbia Highway.

3. The Public Works Director is hereby directed to erect and maintain signs giving notice of this resolution in a conspicuous manner and place at each end of the highway or section of highway affected hereby and at such other places as may be necessary to inform the public.
4. This resolution and the prohibitions stated herein shall be effective upon such time as the signs giving notice are erected and no person shall operate any vehicle or combination of vehicles in violation hereof. The aforesaid signs shall refer to this resolution.
5. This resolution shall become null and void upon the determination by the Public Works Director that it is no longer needed or on

April 30, 1979, whichever occurs first.


