

RESOLUTION NO. 301

A RESOLUTION FORMING THE THREE CITY SERVICE DELIVERY TASK FORCE AND AUTHORIZING UP TO \$2,500.

WHEREAS, the Mayors and Council Presidents of the cities of Fairview, Wood Village and Troutdale are concerned with assuring the desired levels of effective municipal services at the lowest possible cost; and,

WHEREAS, it appears that there may be some efficiency or effectiveness advantages to pooling or coordinating services among the three cities; and,

WHEREAS, the Boundary Commission has further suggested that political consolidation of the three cities may be the best way to serve those citizens; NOW,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF Troutdale THAT:

1. A Three-City Service Delivery (TSD) Task Force is hereby created. The Task Force is to be nine members with three appointees from each of the three cities, one of whom must be an elected official from each City. The TSD Task Force will report to the three City Councils by February 29, 1980 with recommendations on pooling, joint venturing, intergovernmental contracting, coordinating or other actions for improving the efficiency, effectiveness or productivity of municipal services in Fairview, Wood Village and Troutdale. The TSD Task Force will also recommend a second step study if it determines that there may be some other advantages to political consolidation of the cities.
2. A Steering Committee of the three Mayors is hereby created. The Steering Committee is to recommend to the three City Councils in November, 1979 as to the Task Force scope of work, timetable, ground rules, staff and budget necessary to achieve the Task Force goals in Section One of this Resolution.
3. The Mayor is authorized to commit up to \$2,500 as the city's share of this study.
