

RESOLUTION NO. 308

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO BUXTON ROAD.

WHEREAS, Buxton Road is a two lane rural standard road, and

WHEREAS, Buxton Road is receiving increased volumes of traffic because it is the only north/south road serving a large area of Troutdale, and

WHEREAS, the intersection of Buxton Road with Columbia Highway is particularly dangerous, and poses a threat to the public health safety and welfare, and

WHEREAS, Buxton Road is owned and maintained by Multnomah County and Columbia Highway is owned and maintained by the State of Oregon, and

WHEREAS, immediate improvements to Buxton Road would significantly decrease accident potential and aid in the smooth flow of traffic,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, THAT:

1. Multnomah County be requested to make improvements to Buxton Road, particularly between Columbia Highway and 3rd Street, and
2. That such improvements be made during the spring and summer of 1980, and
3. That copies of this resolution be sent to Multnomah County and the State of Oregon.


