

RESOLUTION NO. 309

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING IMPROVEMENTS TO COLUMBIA HIGHWAY

WHEREAS, Columbia Highway is heavily used by bicyclists and pedestrians, and

WHEREAS, There are currently no asphalt shoulders on Columbia Highway, which presents a safety hazard to pedestrians, bicycles and motorists, and

WHEREAS, Columbia Highway is a designated bike route and Scenic Highway, and

WHEREAS, Columbia Highway is owned and maintained by the State of Oregon,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, THAT:

1. The City request that the State of Oregon improve Columbia Highway from Kibling Street to the Sandy River Bridge with six (6') feet asphalt shoulders on both sides of the highway, and
2. That such improvements be completed during the spring or summer of 1980 if at all possible, and
3. That copies of this resolution be forwarded to the appropriate officials with the State of Oregon Department of Transportation.

ADOPTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THIS 14th DAY OF January , 1980.


