WHEREAS, Such service to the community is appreciated by the City Council and by the whole community


NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved that Dr. Packard be commended and recognized for his years of service on the Troutdale Planning Commission, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT City Council wishes to express its deep appreciation for said service to the public.


