

RESOLUTION NO. 346-R

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING MULTNOMAH COUNTY TO CONSIDER DEVELOPMENT PROPOSALS FOR THE COUNTY FARM PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, Multnomah County is the owner of a large parcel of land within the City limits of the City of Troutdale; and

WHEREAS, this parcel has a great potential for development in a manner which would be financially beneficial to public agencies within Multnomah County, and which would further provide employment opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes a Comprehensive Plan for the entire County Farm property is necessary to ensure maximum benefits from any development that takes place on this property; and

WHEREAS, a review of private development proposals for the County Farm property may assist public agencies in the development of alternative future uses for this property; and

WHEREAS, a private development firm has submitted a conceptual development plan to the Troutdale City Council, and has asked that the City Council review said proposal and endorse it so that it may be submitted to the Multnomah County Board of Commissioners; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT


The "Proposal to Develop a Major Employment Center and a Covered Multi-Use Stadium on the Multnomah County Farm Property", presented by Michael Monahan of the C. J. and I. Corporation be endorsed in concept by the City Council; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City Council requests that the Multnomah Board of County Commissioners give serious attention and consideration to this particular development proposal.


