

RESOLUTION NO. 350-R

A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING THE PURCHASE OF POLICE CARS FROM COMPETITION BIDDING.

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 220, as amended, the Council finds that:

- (a) No bids have been received pursuant to a notice duly given and inviting bids for the purchase of police cars.
- (b) The lack of bidding for police vehicles will not result in favoritism or substantially reduce competition in awarding the contract.
- (c) The exemption from bidding for police vehicles is likely to produce substantial cost savings to the City.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, that staff be authorized to negotiate an agreement to purchase or lease with option to purchase police vehicles and that the execution of the agreement shall be conditioned upon the approval of the City Council

ADOPTED by the Common Council of the City of Troutdale this 26th day of June, 1980.


