

RESOLUTION NO. 353-R

A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING THE PURCHASE OF SHELVES AND SHELVING CARRIAGES FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING.

WHEREAS, THE FINANCE DIRECTOR DETERMINED THE TYPE OF SHELVING NECESSARY FOR THE RECORDS VAULT STORAGE, AND

WHEREAS, THE FINANCE DIRECTOR CALLED VARIOUS COMPANIES IN THE AREA SEEKING A FIRM THAT HANDLED SUCH EQUIPMENT, AND

WHEREAS, THE FINANCE DIRECTOR COULD FIND NO LOCAL DISTRIBUTOR, SHE REQUESTED WHITE STORAGE AND RETRIEVAL SYSTEMS TO BID ON THE EQUIPMENT, AND

WHEREAS, WHITE STORAGE AND RETRIEVAL SYSTEMS USES OFFICE AND SECURITY SYSTEMS AS ITS AGENT ON THE WEST COAST, AND

WHEREAS, OFFICE AND SECURITY SYSTEMS IS ALSO AN AGENT FOR SPACE SAVER SYSTEM (A CARRIAGE VENDOR ALSO), AND FOR AURORA STEEL SHELVING.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

SECTION 1. THAT OFFICE AND SECURITY SYSTEMS, BEING AN AGENT FOR THREE VENDORS, DID PROCURE THE LOWEST POSSIBLE PRICE FOR THE CITY. (WHITE BID \$6500.00) (SPACE SAVER BID \$2,328.30) (AURORA STEEL SHELVING BID \$2,847.15).


SECTION 2. THE FINANCE DIRECTOR DID CALL MORE THAN THREE VENDORS IN THE PORTLAND AREA FOR BIDS AND NONE HANDLED THE SYSTEM REQUIRED.

SECTION 3. WITH THE ABOVE FINDINGS, THE PURCHASE OF THE SHELVING AND SHELVING CARRIAGES ARE EXEMPT FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING.

ADOPTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THIS 8TH DAY OF JULY, 1980.


