

RESOLUTION NO. 361-R

A RESOLUTION FORMING A CITIZENS TASK FORCE ON HOUSEKEEPING AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY CHARTER.

WHEREAS, The City Council has determined that some of the provisions of the 1942 City Charter for what was a city of around 500, are not appropriate to our 1980 requirements with a city of over 5,000; and

WHEREAS, portions of the Charter actually impede our progress and cause inefficiency; and

WHEREAS, the Council also finds the basic structure of our government under this Charter is working satisfactorily; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT,

- 1.) A Citizens Task Force is hereby formed to report back to the City Council by September 2, 1980 as to the needed and limited types of changes of a "housekeeping" nature which would make the City Charter more effective and City operations more efficient.
- 2.) The Task Force shall be appointed by the Mayor with at least one member from the Council, one from the Planning Commission and one from the Budget Committee.
- 3.) The City Attorney is to prepare initial suggestions for the Task Force and then the Task Force's final report in election resolution form for the November, 1980 General Election.
