

RESOLUTION NO. 378-R

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT A CHARTER AMENDMENT TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE AMENDING SECTION 11.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE that the following proposed amendment to the city charter be and the same is hereby proposed to be submitted to the legal voters of Troutdale for their adoption or rejection at the regular election to be held on the 4th day of November, 1980, as in this resolution provided:

AN ACT

To Amend the Charter of the City of Troutdale adopted by the legal voters of Troutdale, Oregon, on August 24, 1942.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT: Section 11 of the Charter of the City of Troutdale be and the same is hereby amended to read:

Section 11. ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS: Administrative officers of the City of Troutdale shall be a treasurer or finance director, a director of public safety, a recorder, a city administrator or executive director, a municipal judge, a city attorney and such other officers as the City Council shall from time to time deem necessary for the proper conduct and management of the city. All administrative officers shall be appointed or removed by the city council pursuant to procedures established by city ordinance. The authority to appoint or remove the municipal judge, city attorney and city administrator or executive director may not be delegated by City Council. All administrative officers shall serve indefinite terms and may be removed at the pleasure of the City Council. Any of the administrative offices may be combined except the municipal judge, the city attorney and the city administrator or executive director.

ADOPTED by the Council this 2ND day of SEPTEMBER, 1980.


