

RESOLUTION NO. 379-R

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT A CHARTER AMENDMENT TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE AMENDING SECTION 12.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE that the following proposed amendment to the city charter be and the same is hereby proposed to be submitted to the legal voters of Troutdale for their adoption or rejection at the regular election to be held on the 4th day of November, 1980, as in this resolution provided:

AN ACT

To Amend the Charter of the City of Troutdale adopted by the legal voters of Troutdale, Oregon, on August 24, 1942 and subsequently amended.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT: Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Troutdale be and the same is hereby amended to read:


Section 12. QUALIFICATIONS OF ELECTIVE OFFICERS: No person may be eligible to fill an elective office unless at the time of their election the person is a qualified voter under the meaning of the Constitution of Oregon and has resided in the City at least six months immediately preceding the election. No Officer elected may continue to serve if he or she ceases to be a resident of the City.


