

RESOLUTION NO. 383 - R

A RESOLUTION DECLARING ISSUES OF LEGISLATIVE CONCERN OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE.

WHEREAS, many of the concerns of the City of Troutdale can be most effectively addressed to the State Legislature after review and with the support of the League of Oregon Cities; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

1. The City requests that the League of Oregon Cities Resolutions Committee and Legislative Committee review and recommend a League position on the following:

1.1 Double-Taxation whereby city residents pay the same county tax even though they receive less county service; and,

1.2 Open-Meetings Law should be changed to allow for Council retreats and work-sessions outside city limits so long as no final decisions are reached; and,

1.3 Corrections Facilities Siting should be only with local approval; and,

1.4 A Home Rule Amendment to the Constitution should be developed by League resources to submit to the voters and to reinstate local control.

2. And that the Mayor and City staff are directed to represent these concerns as the policy position of the Troutdale City Council.


