

A RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITIES FOR THE EAST MULTNOMAH COUNTY SEWER CONSORTIUM.

WHEREAS, A 208 Study was undertaken by CRAG and completed in 1977, which provided that a 201 Facility Plan could be undertaken by Multnomah County, Gresham and Troutdale to further investigate the alternatives of independent expansion versus regionalization for sewage treatment in East Multnomah County, and:

WHEREAS, Multnomah County, Gresham and Troutdale formed a Consortium in 1977, to undertake the studies to further analyze the sewerage requirements of the area, and:

WHEREAS, the Consortium has attempted to obtain Federal financial assistance to undertake the necessary studies and that Federal financial assistance has not yet materialized, and:

WHEREAS, the Consortium has undertaken at its own expense a study to analyze the first task of the proposed comprehensive study effort which has analyzed the costs of a regional sewerage treatment facility and the cost of independently expanding the three existing sewage treatment plants at Inverness, Gresham and Troutdale, and:

WHEREAS, there are significant advantages which may be realized by continuing to function as a Consortium,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY City of Troutdale THAT:

1. A study prepared by Lee Engineering, Inc . dated September 10, 1980, entitled, "East Multnomah County Sewer Consortium Study," is hereby approved.
2. A recommendation that treatment of sewage for East Multnomah County be provided by the independent expansion of the existing treatment facilities through the year 2000 is hereby adopted.
3. There is a potential for cost reduction for operation and maintenance by continuing the Consortium effort toward analyzing the benefits of joint management, sludge disposal, laboratory testing, etc., and future study through a joint 201 planning effort should be undertaken as a Consortium including Multnomah County, Gresham and Troutdale.

4. This resolution together with the report entitled "East Multnomah County Sewer Consortium Study" be forwarded to Metro, DEQ and EPA for their approval and that the 208 Study be clarified or changed to allow for the independent expansion of the Inverness, Gresham, and Troutdale sewage treatment facilities to provide sewage service to the East County area through the year 2000.


