

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A CITY-WIDE POLICY OF EMERGENCY PREPARED-
NESS.

WHEREAS, the City Charter establishes the power and responsibility to supervise the safety and welfare of residents within the geographical boundaries of the City of Troutdale.

WHEREAS, the establishment of a policy is of cardinal importance to ensure that the City workforce is prepared for an unforeseen event, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

SECTION 1.

- 1.1 It is the policy of the City of Troutdale to efficiently manage any and all unforeseen events that impact the safety and health of the City's residents in an expeditious manner with the utmost concern for life and property.
- 1.2 It is the policy of the City to maintain a network of documents that allow the City to seek mutual aid, in an expeditious fashion, and operate under emergency conditions outside the normal policies to bring such an event to a rapid, successful conclusion.

SECTION 2.

- 2.1 In order to achieve these policy goals it is necessary that the following steps be accomplished.
 - 2.1.1 The Common Council must pass an enabling ordinance to establish emergency powers.
 - 2.1.2 That the City Administrator adopt a City-wide standard procedure for emergency management.
 - 2.1.3 That each City Department create and maintain a series of Departmental guidelines directed at all forms of emergency management.

SECTION 3.


The City Administrator shall ensure that this effort is completed and maintained in readiness.


