

RESOLUTION NO. 414 -R

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR A CABLE COMMUNICATIONS FRANCHISE

WHEREAS, The City of Troutdale is interested in reviewing proposals from parties interested in the construction, operation and maintenance of a Cable Communications System within the East Multnomah County area; and

WHEREAS, Multnomah County, together with the Cities of Gresham, Fairview, Troutdale, Wood Village and Maywood Park have developed a "Request for Proposals" document to be made available to interested bidders; and

WHEREAS, The Three Cities Cable Communications Task Force, and the Multnomah County Cable Communications Task Force have reviewed the Request for Proposals, and have recommended its acceptance by the jurisdictions involved; and

WHEREAS, The Request for Proposals represents the present intention of the County and Cities as to the contents and evaluation of Proposals and as to the ultimate franchise, but does not obligate the County or the Cities to enter into a franchise agreement; and

WHEREAS, The Provisions for the Request for Proposals are policy guidelines adopted by the County and the Cities, but do not legally bind the jurisdictions in any way unless and until they are included in a formal franchise agreement; and

WHEREAS, It is understood that any franchise issued will be subject to an authorizing Ordinance by the City of Troutdale, which may place binding requirements on a licensee; NOW,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The City of Troutdale hereby accepts the Request for Proposals for a Cable Communications franchise as submitted by the Three Cities Cable Communications Task Force and the Multnomah County Cable Communications Task Force; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: The City of Troutdale in accepting this Proposal is in no way bound by the Proposal and may withdraw from the franchising process at any time prior to the entering into a formal franchise agreement.


