

RESOLUTION NO. 422-R

A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE METROPOLITAN SERVICE DISTRICT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE YARD DEBRIS DISPOSAL PROJECT, MAY 16 THROUGH MAY 24, 1981.

WHEREAS, The City of Troutdale recognizes that there is increasing pressure on area landfills; and,

WHEREAS, Alternatives for the disposal of unprocessed material must be addressed by all communities; and,

WHEREAS, MSD has been awarded a \$265,000 grant to explore other methods of disposal of yard debris; and,

WHEREAS, The City of Troutdale owns property known as Obrist Pit, which is suitable as a collection and processing site; and,

WHEREAS, Metro (MSD) has agreed to reimburse the City of Troutdale for expenses incurred through participation in the project, not to exceed \$2,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City of Troutdale agrees to participate in the Metro Yard Debris Disposal Project, May 18 through May 24, 1981, under the provisions and conditions of the agreement attached to this resolution as Exhibit "A", a copy of which is so marked, attached hereto and made a part of this resolution.
