

RESOLUTION NO. 447-R

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING REVIEW OF THE LAND CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

WHEREAS, The City of Troutdale, by Charter, assumes responsibility for providing services and guiding the growth of the community, and

WHEREAS, a process as required by state law was followed while developing the Comprehensive Plan, and

WHEREAS, adequate allowance for public forum was given to insure all interested parties had opportunity to comment, and

WHEREAS, the policies adopted reflected the desires of the community participants who contributed to the Plan's development, and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted the Comprehensive Plan because the Plan addressed community land use needs, and

WHEREAS, the Plan has been used to direct community growth and development over the last three years in an effective and positive manner and has been found sufficient for the purpose intended,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:


The original intent of the Oregon State Legislature has been met by providing a long-term planning document for all jurisdictions in the State of Oregon. Subsequent revisions and requirements have been based upon special interest group pressures on elected and appointed officials individually and have led to the deterioration of local control.

It is the conviction of this Common Council that the Land Conservation and Development Commission be carefully reviewed and be placed under the Sunset laws set forth by the State Legislature.
