

RESOLUTION NO. 465-R

A RESOLUTION TO RESCIND RESOLUTION NO. 463 AND TO SUBMIT TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE AT A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD JUNE 29, 1982, A PROPOSITION FOR A GENERAL FUND TAX LEVY FOR FISCAL YEAR 1982-83

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 463, calling for a Tax Base Election and Charter Amendment did not meet filing date requirements; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary to provide the basic levels of municipal services in the Recommended Budget for 1982-83; and,

WHEREAS, the Budget Committee has carefully considered and recommended the 1982-83 Budget;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

Section 1 : Resolution No. 463 is hereby rescinded.

Section 2 : An election is hereby called to be held on Tuesday, June 29, 1982 from the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. at which time a measure shall be submitted to the voters of the City of Troutdale, which, if approved, would authorize a general fund operating tax levy for the 1982-83 tax year.

Section 3 : Form of the Ballot Question:

Special Operating Levy

Question : Shall the City of Troutdale levy \$339,382 outside the tax base for fiscal year 1982-83?

Explanation : This measure authorizes the City to levy property taxes of \$339,382 in 1982-83 outside the 6% limitation specified in Article XI, Section II, Oregon Constitution. The levy will be used for general fund purposes and will offset higher costs due to inflation and reduced state-shared and growth-related revenues. In addition, street lighting services previously funded by serial tax levies, which expire on June 30, 1982, will be funded by this levy in 1982-83. It is also necessary to provide for legal commitments related to the "Obrist Pit". Passage of the levy will permit the City to maintain the present level of service, including street lighting, and meet the City's commitments. Without this levy, the City cannot maintain 24 hour police protection, maintain neighborhood parks, provide street lighting, adequately provide for economic development or code enforcement and meet its commitments. If this measure is approved, \$339,382 of the taxes levied


in 1982-83 fiscal year will be totally funded by local taxpayers without any partial state payment.

Section 4 : The Finance Director/City Recorder is directed to call for such hearings and prepare such notices as necessary to place this ballot measure on the June 29, 1982 election.


