

RESOLUTION NO. 467-R

RESOLUTION DECLARING OPPOSITION TO SENATE BILL 2172 AS
PROPOSED BY THE SENATE OF THE UNITED STATES.

WHEREAS, The City of Troutdale is a home-rule City and therefore, has the right to establish regulations regarding commercial operations within the City limits; and

WHEREAS, As a home-rule City, Troutdale has the power to issue Franchises within its' boundaries and therefore, set regulations regarding the franchise; and

WHEREAS, The City of Troutdale is the government agency having the closest contact with the citizens it serves and is most cognizant of the needs and requirements of its' citizens; and

WHEREAS, The City of Troutdale recognizes the authority of the legislature to establish general regulatory principles for the operation of interstate enterprises.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City of Troutdale generally supports the efforts of the legislature in establishing a regulatory framework for the operation of cable television.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

The City of Troutdale desires legislation enacted by the federal government be based on minimum standards for the cable industry, recognizing the right of local jurisdictions to regulate cable franchises within their boundaries.
