

RESOLUTION NO. 472-R

A Resolution to Authorize the Use of Certain Property for Park Purposes.

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale is the owner of the following described real property:

A tract of land in Section 25, Township 1 North, Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian, Multnomah County, Oregon, described as follows: BEGINNING at the Southeast corner of Block 28, First Addition to Troutdale, Multnomah County, Oregon; thence North $33^{\circ} 58'$ East 600.0 feet, more or less, to an old railroad coupling link; thence North $50^{\circ} 04'$ East 150.0 feet to an iron stake; said iron stake being the true point of beginning of the tract to be herein described; thence from the above described true point of beginning North $50^{\circ} 04'$ East 266.8 feet to an iron stake in the westerly side line of the County Road now known as the Crown Point Highway; thence North $39^{\circ} 18'$ West along the Westerly side line of said highway 288.55 feet to an iron stake; thence South $58^{\circ} 09'$ West 98.5 feet to an iron stake; thence South $39^{\circ} 10'$ East 62.2 feet to an iron stake; thence South $10^{\circ} 17'$ West 248.3 feet to an iron stake; thence South $53^{\circ} 16'$ East 83.45 feet to the place of beginning.

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed Resolution No. 299 on the 13th day of November, 1979, which resolution adopted the Troutdale Parks Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Troutdale Parks Plan has identified the above-described property as appropriate and desirable for use as a park and open space,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Troutdale that:


- (1) The above-described property shall henceforth be known as the "Harlow House Park".
- (2) The Harlow House Park shall be open for use by the general public as of the 1st day of July, 1982.
- (3) The above-described property shall be maintained as a park by the city and remain open for public use so long as it shall remain identified as appropriate and desirable for such purpose by the Troutdale Parks Plan.
