

RESOLUTION NO 485-R

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ADOPTION OF THE UNIFORM FIRE CODE, 1982 EDITION, AS AMENDED BY RFPD #10 1-1982 AND AUTHORIZING THE ENFORCEMENT OF SAID CODE WITHIN THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale is situated within the boundaries of the Multnomah County Rural Fire Protection District #10, and all territory, land and real property within the City boundaries are a part of said Fire District and as such, said Fire District furnishes to this City, its residents and inhabitants and property, fire protection and prevention services; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 498.920 et seq, the provisions of the new and revised Uniform Fire Code cannot become effective and be applicable to this jurisdiction without the approval of the City Council of the City of Troutdale; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of the Uniform Revised Fire Code as aforesaid, is in the best interest of the District, the City and the residents, inhabitants and properties located therein and will provide the optimum and highest degree of fire prevention and protection services available to this jurisdiction at this time, and should be adopted and made effective herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

1. Pursuant to ORS Chapter 498, the Common Council hereby authorizes the enforcement of the Uniform Fire Code, 1982 Edition, as amended by Ordinance 1-1982 of the Multnomah County Rural Fire Protection District #10 with the exception that Sections 4,5 and 6 thereof shall be void and of no force or effect within the City of Troutdale.
2. The effective date of the Uniform Fire Code as amended and adopted by the City of Troutdale shall be the 25th day of February, 1983.
