**RESOLUTION APPROVING A WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLANNING GRANT PRELIMINARY APPLICATION TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY IN CONJUNCTION WITH GRESHAM CENTRAL COUNTY SERVICE DISTRICT, MULTNOMAH COUNTY, AND PORTLAND**

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Water Pollution Control Act of 1972, amended December 29, 1981, provides assistance to local jurisdictions in the United States to carry out Water Quality Management Planning; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 205 (j) of the Act provides funds for developing an implementation plan to obtain State and local financial and regulatory commitments to implement measures for cost effective and locally acceptable measures to meet and maintain water quality standards; and

**WHEREAS**, the Unincorporated area of Central Multnomah County from the City limits of Portland to the Urban Containment Line and exempting the incorporated Cities of Gresham, Fairview, Troutdale, and Wood Village consists of an approximately 30-square mile urbanized area that is served primarily by substandard on-site subsurface sewage disposal systems which have been identified by the State Department of Environmental Quality as a source of contaminants to the groundwaters of the area; and

**WHEREAS**, the area consists of four separate drainage basins identified in the 208 Regional Waste Water Treatment Plan as the designated service area of the Central County Service District (Inverness), and the Cities of Gresham, Portland (Johnson Creek), and Troutdale; and

**WHEREAS**, the State Department of Environmental Quality has directed entities responsible for providing sewerage service to cesspool areas to submit detailed plans, scheduling, priorities, phasing, and identification of financial mechanisms for sewerage service to cesspool areas by July 1, 1984 and has directed that installation of new cesspools and seepage pits will be prohibited in the designated service areas effective January 1, 1985; and

**WHEREAS**, the four jurisdictions of Gresham, Central County Service District (Multnomah County), Portland, and Troutdale have participated since 1977 in the East Multnomah County Sanitary Sewer Consortium, with Multnomah County acting as the lead agency, and have proposed jointly applying for Federal Water Pollution Control Act funding administered by the State Department of Environmental Quality; and

**WHEREAS**, a Review Board will be formed, to be comprised of one elected official to represent each public agency, to review the work of the grant and make recommendations to the members of the Troutdale City Council.


**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF**

**TROUTDALE, THAT** the City of Troutdale, Oregon, hereby approves participation of Troutdale, acting as a member of the East Multnomah County Sanitary Sewer Consortium to participate with Fairview, Gresham, and Wood Village in submitting a Preapplication, attached as Exhibit "A", to the State Department of Environmental Quality for a 75% State-funded grant, with the 25% local match consisting of in-kind contribution by all participants, for the purpose of developing a financial plan and citizen information and participation program to implement sewer system construction in the cesspool areas of the Troutdale service area.


