

RESOLUTION 496--R

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FILING OF APPLICATION WITH THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION, U.S. DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, FOR A GRANT UNDER THE TERMS OF PUBLIC LAW 89-136, AS AMENDED, IN CONJUNCTION WITH GRESHAM, CENTRAL COUNTY SERVICE DISTRICT, MULTNOMAH COUNTY, AND PORTLAND.

**WHEREAS,** The Economic Development Administration has announced that supplemental funds appropriated under the Emergency Jobs Act are available for Public Works and Economic Development Act of 1965; and

**WHEREAS,** One of the grant objectives is to stimulate local economic development and private sector employment through construction of needed public facilities that emphasize long-term economic development benefits; and

**WHEREAS,** the four jurisdictions of Gresham, Central County Service District (Multnomah County), Portland and Troutdale have participated since 1977 in the East Multnomah County Sanitary Sewer Consortium with Multnomah County acting as the lead agency, and have proposed jointly applying for Federal Emergency Jobs Act grant money currently available; and

**WHEREAS,** the four jurisdictions have identified the lack of sanitary sewers as a major impediment to industrial development of lands within their jurisdictions; and

**WHEREAS,** the congressional representatives of the four jurisdictions have supported the Consortium's efforts in applying for available funds; and


**WHEREAS,** The City of Troutdale is prepared to meet the requirements of application set-forth by the Economic Development Administration and to meet requirements established by East Multnomah County Sewer Consortium.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE,** THAT Pamela L. Christian is hereby authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the City of Troutdale, Oregon in cooperation with and as a member of the East Multnomah County Sanitary Sewer Consortium with the Economic Development Administration, U.S. Department of Commerce, for a grant to aid in financing the construction of approximately 9,800 feet of sewer pipe, pump equipment and/or lift station modifications as required, within the City of Troutdale in conjunction with the construction of projects located within the City of Gresham, Multnomah County and the City of Portland.

The application will be made by the East Multnomah Sanitary Sewer Consortium as lead agency for the Cities of Gresham, Portland, Troutdale and Mid-County Service District (Multnomah County).
