

RESOLUTION NO. 498-R

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE AT A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD AUGUST 9, 1983; A REFERENDUM TO REPEAL REQUEST TO ANNEX CITY TO LIGHTING DISTRICT

WHEREAS, a petition containing the requisite number of valid signatures to refer Resolution 491-R to the voters has been filed with the City Recorder,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

Section 1.

Call for Election: An election is hereby called to be held on Tuesday, August 9, 1983 from the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. (Pacific Daylight Time) at which time a referendum measure shall be submitted to the voters of the City of Troutdale, which, if approved, will repeal Resolution 491-R.

Section 2.

The Ballot question shall read as follows:

Title: "Referendum to Repeal Request to Annex City to Lighting District."

Question: Shall Resolution 491-R requesting City annexion to the Mid-County Street Lighting Service District No. 14 be repealed?

Purpose: On April 12, 1983, the Common Council of the City of Troutdale adopted Resolution 491-R which requested that the territory within the city be annexed to Mid-County Street Lighting Service District No. 14. The purpose of this measure is to withdraw the request by repealing Resolution 491-R. If this measure passes, the request will be withdrawn.


Section 3.

The Finance Director/City Recorder is directed to prepare such notices as necessary to call for the August 9, 1983 election.


