

RESOLUTION NO. 519-R

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CHANGE IN THE DESCRIBED ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION WORK ELEMENTS.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Troutdale, together with other members of the East Multnomah County Sewer Consortium, has been awarded a Grant for the construction of sewer lines to service sites of industrial/commercial significance; and

**WHEREAS**, one element of the Troutdale system includes Multnomah County properties between Halsey on the south and West Columbia Highway on the north; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has been unable to deliver the City of Troutdale with assurances that its planning efforts will be directed to that end; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has reviewed other commercial/industrial sites that will provide such certification of future development either through existing zone restrictions or through ownership certifications; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sewer Consortium and the Economic Development Administration support the City's position regarding a potential relocation of facilities.


**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT** the City staff proceed with a relocation effort should the County not respond within a time frame acceptable to the City and the project schedule.
