

RESOLUTION NO. 526-R

RESOLUTION AMENDING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
MULTNOMAH COUNTY, AND THE CITIES OF GRESHAM, TROUTDALE,
FAIRVIEW AND WOOD VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, The intergovernmental agreement establishes a commission to monitor, supervise and regulate the construction and operation of a joint cable communications system, and

WHEREAS, The commission has reviewed the requested amendment to the intergovernmental agreement and recommends adoption by all jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, The City of Troutdale has reviewed the requested amendment to the intergovernmental agreement and finds the requirement of notification to be in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The agreement between Multnomah County and the cities of Gresham, Troutdale, Fairview and Wood Village creating the Multnomah Cable Regulatory Commission is hereby amended to add a new subparagraph E to Section 10 which shall read as follows:

"E. Notice to Jurisdictions. No action of the MULTNOMAH CABLE REGULATORY COMMISSION which allows discretionary review or full authority of the jurisdiction shall be deemed effective unless a copy of the resolution or other action taken by the Commission is filed with the Clerk • Recorder of each oif the member jurisdictions within ten (10) days of such action.


All other provisions of the Intergovernmental Agreement creating the MULTNOMAH CABLE REGULATORY COMMISSION shall be unaffected by this amendment."


