

RESOLUTION NO. 535-R

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF TROUTDALE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF OREGON DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS.

WHEREAS, The City of Troutdale, the State of Oregon and Multnomah County deem it in the best interest of all parties to construct a storm sewer outfall on Columbia Highway from Buxton to BeaverCreek; and

WHEREAS, The State of Oregon has authorized financial participation in the amount of 33 1/3% (not to exceed a maximum amount of \$44,000); and

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale has budgeted funds for the construction of this project in fiscal year 1985; and

WHEREAS, The City of Troutdale is entering into negotiations with Multnomah County for participation in this project,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The Mayor be authorized to execute the corporative improvement agreement (Exhibit "A") between the City of Troutdale and the State of Oregon; and

The City staff be instructed to prepare preliminary designs and specifications for this project; and

The City staff be directed to enter into negotiations with Multnomah County for their participation.


