A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MULTNOMAH COUNTY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A STORMWATER OUTFALL IN THE COLUMBIA HIGHWAY.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

1. The City has entered into an agreement with the State of Oregon Division of Highways and has established budgetary funds and a local improvement district to construct a stormwater outfall facility on the Columbia Scenic Highway from Buxton Street on the west discharging into Beaver Creek on the east.
2. Multnomah County did hereby agree to contribute to the construction of this facility and to sever its' connection with the Halsey Local Improvement District Stormwater Outfall system.
3. It is in the best interest of the City of Troutdale to enter into an agreement with the County for financial assistance in the construction of this project.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF TROUTDALE HEREBY AUTHORIZES ITS' MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY AND SETTING THAT CONTRIBUTION LEVEL AT \$44,000.


