

RESOLUTION NO. 568-R

A RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE REMOVAL, OR DIVERSION, OF WATERS FROM THE SANDY RIVER.

WHEREAS, the lower reaches of the Sandy River pass through Troutdale and have an affect upon the community's water supply, wastewater discharge, community aesthetics, together with the livelihood of many Troutdale residents and businesses, and

WHEREAS, a reduction in the quantity of water within the river system may affect Troutdale's current, and projected, ground water requirements, and

WHEREAS, a reduction of flows within the Sandy River system may affect the dilution of wastewater discharges and their associated permits, and

WHEREAS, the Sandy River is identified as one of the major sources of asthetic and recreational pleasure for both Troutdale citizens and regional citizens alike, and

WHEREAS, many Troutdale businesses and citizens make, or take, a portion of their livelihood from the benefits of this river.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, THAT:

1. The City opposes any additional removal or diversion of water from this river system.
2. The City of Troutdale supports the intervenor's position regarding the matter of Permit Application No. 63266 - City of Portland Hydro-Electric Power Diversion for Bull Run River.
3. The City provide witnesses and exhibits as necessary to support its opposition to the diversion of water from the Sandy River system.


