

RESOLUTION 594-R

A RESOLUTION STATING TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL'S OPPOSITION TO SITING A HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL SITE ADJACENT TO ANY NATURAL WATER WAY WITHOUT FULL AND COMPLETE DISCLOSURE TO ALL JURISDICTIONS THAT MAY BE AFFECTED.

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed a proposal to site a hazardous waste disposal facility in Grant County Washington; and

WHEREAS, the proposal site is within 2,500 feet of the Columbia River; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale is bounded by the Columbia River and other natural waterways; and

WHEREAS, siting of potentially hazardous facilities on any of the waterways could pose a danger to the safety, well being and economics of citizens of Troutdale; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City Council of the City of Troutdale opposes any sitings of hazardous facilities on any natural waterway that bounds or otherwise affects the City without full disclosure to all jurisdictions by proposer.

Be it further resolved that such proposals and attendant impact studies be reviewed at public hearings of each jurisdiction that may be affected because of their proximity to the waterways.


