

RESOLUTION NO. 606-R

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE GRANT THE CITY OF TROUTDALE CERTAIN CODE ADDITIONS

WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Troutdale have suffered excessive damage to their homes due to heavy and severe east winds, and

WHEREAS, in December 1985, one hundred thirty-seven homes lost portions of roofing, and

WHEREAS, the code for application of roofing materials is insufficient and does not allow roofing materials to withstand the high velocity of the prevailing east wind in Troutdale, and

WHEREAS, this addition to the code is in the public interest, health, safety and welfare:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:


All asphaltic or fiberglass shingles be hand nailed with a minimum of six (6) required nails per shingle; and in addition

From September to March of each year, all asphaltic or fiberglass shingles shall be full tab hand sealed.
