

RESOLUTION NO. 611 -R

A RESOLUTION TERMINATING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PORTLAND AND THE CITY OF TROUTDALE PROVIDING FOR DISBURSEMENT OF TROUTDALE 911 REVENUES TO CITY OF PORTLAND.

WHEREAS, An intergovernmental agreement between City of Troutdale and City of Portland became effective July 1, 1982; and

WHEREAS, The agreement allowed for direct disbursement of City of Troutdale 911 revenues to City of Portland which administers Bureau of Emergency Communications; and

WHEREAS, Certain contractual issues are now being reconsidered which may affect expenditure policies of BOEC.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The City of Troutdale terminates the intergovernmental agreement regarding direct disbursement of 911 funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

The City of Troutdale now desires to receive the 911 revenues directly from the State of Oregon Emergency Management Division, and directs that those funds will be disbursed to BOEC upon submission of verified quarterly statements.
