

RESOLUTION NO. 615-R-R

RESOLUTION REQUIRING PROOF OF COMPLIANCE WITH ORS
REGARDING DEMOLITION OF EDGEFIELD MANOR

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes 358.605 through 358.690 set forth a review process required for political subdivisions before transferring or otherwise divesting itself of property listed on Historic Places Registry exists and is part of the Oregon State Law; and

WHEREAS, Multnomah County has expressed a desire to demolish Edgefield Manor; and

WHEREAS, The County has, in fact, requested bids for the demolition of the referenced bulding; and


WHEREAS, Multnomah County has failed to follow procedures outlined in ORS regarding structural review of the building by the Oregon Historic Preservation office; and

WHEREAS, The City of Troutdale wishes to avoid any conflict or legal challenge to the potential demolition of Edgefield Manor.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of Troutdale will not issue demolition permits to Multnomah County for the purpose of demolishing Edgefield Manor until proof of evaluation by the Oregon Historic Preservation office is presented to the Building Official of the City of Troutdale, along with application for a demolition permit.


