

RESOLUTION NO. 617-R

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE A TWO-YEAR OPERATING SERIAL LEVY AT A SPECIAL ELECTION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

1. Call for Election: An election is hereby called to be held on Tuesday, June 24, 1986, which election within Multnomah County, will be conducted by mail. This measure shall be submitted to the voters of the City of Troutdale and which if approved, would authorize a two-year general fund operating levy beginning 1986-87.
2. Directive to City Recorder: The City Recorder shall cause a notice to be published in the Gresham Outlook on June 4, 1986 and June 7, 1986, giving notice that a measure election shall be held on June 24, 1986 to submit said measure to the legal voters of the City of Troutdale for their approval or disapproval. The notice shall state that the election will be conducted by mail. The full text of the measure shall appear in the notice.
3. Form of Ballot:

| QUESTION:    | Shall City of Troutdale levy \$0.65 per \$1,000 of assessed value for two years outside the tax base beginning 1986-87.  |
| EXPLANATION: | The purpose of this measure is to support the general operations of the City of Troutdale and to maintain current level of services provided to the citizens of Troutdale. It is also necessary to offset the loss of Federal revenues, which supported City services and programs. This two-year operating serial levy at \$0.65 per \$1,000 of assessed value will raise an estimated \$101,870 in 1986-87 and an estimated \$107,325 in 1987-88 outside the tax base. |
