

RESOLUTION NO. 627-R

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE A ONE-YEAR OPERATING LEVY AT A SPECIAL ELECTION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

1. Call for Election: An election is hereby called to be held on Tuesday, August 12, 1986, which election within Multnomah County, will be conducted by mail. This measure shall be submitted to the voters of the City of Troutdale and which, if approved, would authorize a one-year general fund special operating levy beginning 1986-87.
2. Directive to City Recorder: The City Recorder shall cause a notice to be published in the Gresham Outlook on July 16, 1986 and July 23, 1986, giving notice that a measure is to be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Troutdale for their approval or disapproval. The notice shall state that the election will be conducted by mail. The full text of the measure shall appear in the notice.
3. Form of Ballot:

CAPTION: One-Year Operating Levy.

QUESTION: Shall City of Troutdale levy \$88,289.00 outside the tax base for operating purposes for 1986-87?

EXPLANATION: The purpose of this measure is to support the general operations of the City of Troutdale and to maintain current level of services provided to the Citizens of Troutdale. This measure will authorize the City of Troutdale to levy \$88,289.00 for one year outside its tax base for 1986-87 and provides for hiring one police officer, maintaining one receptionist position, increased costs of property, and liability insurance premiums, to pay for the recycling program mandated by Oregon State law, and to keep City Hall open to the public Monday through Friday. Approval of this measure would add approximately 0.57 per \$1,000 assessed value to property taxes. It is also necessary to offset the loss of Federal revenues which supported City services and programs. The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the county assessor at the time of estimate.
