

A RESOLUTION STATING THAT THERE ARE PROCEDURAL DEFECTS IN THE CITY OF TROUTDALE'S BALLOT MEASURE FOR THE SEPTEMBER 16, 1986 ELECTION AND ACTION TO REMOVE FROM BALLOT.

WHEREAS, In consideration of the defeat of Ballot Measure #51 held on the Election of August 12, 1986; and

WHEREAS, The Notice of Measure Election for September 16, 1986 did not contain any changes from the August 12, 1986 Notice of Measure Election; and

WHEREAS, The City Recorder did meet the filing deadline and the necessary publication timeframes for Public Notification; and

WHEREAS, On August 15, 1986 it was found that there were procedural defects; and

WHEREAS, A Special Meeting of the City Council was called, the media was informed, and on August 16, 1986 at 10:30 a.m. met to determine alternatives to remove the ballot measure for the September 16, 1986 election; and

WHEREAS, It is determined that there were procedural defects in the submission of the Notice of Measure Election for the September 16, 1986 Ballot; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The Notice of Measure Election filing for the September 16, 1986 election is found to have procedural defects, and the City Attorney is directed to take the necessary steps to withdraw the tax measure from the ballot; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

Should no process be found to withdraw the measure, the City Council will not accept the results from the September 16, 1986, nor levy the tax from the election.
