

RESOLUTION NO. 638-R

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A "NO PARKING" ZONE A CERTAIN DISTANCE EAST AND WEST OF THE INTERSECTION OF GRAHAM ROAD AND 257TH AVENUE.

WHEREAS, Improvements to the state and local road system is vital to the City of Troutdale and Multnomah County, and

WHEREAS, Establishment of a no parking zone at major intersections is necessary to provide vision clearance for vehicular traffic, and

WHEREAS, Elimination of on-street parking at major intersections will protect the safety and welfare of pedestrian, bicycle and vehicular traffic, and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Troutdale to support elimination of on-street parking in certain areas of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

On-street parking be prohibited for a certain distance East and West of the intersection of Graham Road and 257th Avenue more specifically described as follows:

From approximately Kendall Street on the east to approximately Halsey Street on the west and on both sides, north and south, of Columbia Highway. (Exhibit A).


