

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TROUTDALE OPPOSITION TO BALLOT
MEASURE 9

WHEREAS, The November 4, 1986 General Election wil place Ballot Measure 9 before the voters which will severely restrict the services provided by the City of Troutdale to its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure 9, the 1 1/2% property tax limit, will result in a 23.7% reduction for fiscal year 1987-88, and 42.7% reduction in fiscal year 1988-89; and

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure 9 will limit the City's ability to capture benefit of economic growth by limiting the increase in assessed value to 2% per year; and

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure 9 will place the State Legislature in the role of apportioning tax revenues afte the 1987-88 fiscal year, thereby eliminating local district detemination; and

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure 9 has the potential of reducing other State shared revenues to cities, further reducing City resources; and

WHEREAS, Reductions of \$191,933 for fiscal year 1988-89 will eliminate services required to qualify as a full-service City;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE opposes Ballot Measure 9; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

1. City Council opposes any other tax restrictions on the ability of local jurisdictions to provide adequate services and programs to its citizens.
