

RESOLUTION NO. 650 -R

A RESOLUTION PETITIONING THE MULTNOMAH COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO INITIATE RE-NEGOTIATION OF FORMULA FOR TRANSFER OF COUNTY GAS TAX REVENUES TO THE CITY OF PORTLAND.

WHEREAS, Multnomah County retains responsibility for operation, maintenance and construction of major arterial roadways in the county; and

WHEREAS, East Multnomah County is continuing to grow and develop the transportation needs are also growing; and

WHEREAS, The formula for transfer of Multnomah County gas tax revenues unfairly restricts funding of East Multnomah County transportation needs; and

WHEREAS, The population element of the transfer formula serves to compensate the City of Portland twice for population increases; and

WHEREAS, The State Legislature has approved State Gas Tax increases whose benefits will not be shared proportionately county-wide because of the population formula,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City Council of the City of Troutdale unanimously petitions Multnomah County Board of Commission take steps to re-open negotiations with the City of Portland for the purpose of deleting the element of payment for population increases from future transfers of Gas Tax Revenues to the City of Portland.
