

RESOLUTION NO. 658 -R

A RESOLUTION DECLARING INTENT FOR A MAY 19, 1987 SPECIAL LEVY ELECTION AND REQUEST SHORTER FILING PERIOD FROM TAX SUPERVISION AND CONSERVATION COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, ORS 294.655 requires the levying board proposing to ask elector approval of a special tax levy to notify the Tax Supervision and Conservation Commission in writing not less than 55 days prior to the date of such election; and

WHEREAS, the next election date after March 31, 1987, occurs on May 19, 1987; and

WHEREAS, the 55 day notice falls on March 25, 1987, and therefore, the results of the March 31, 1987, special levy will occur after the filing due date; and

WHEREAS, ORS 294.655 allows the Tax Supervision and Conservation Commission authority to approve a shorter filing time period;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

1. The Common Council declares its intent to call for a May 19, 1987, special levy election should the March 31, 1987, election results be unfavorable; and
2. City staff is directed to advise Tax Supervision and Conservation Commission of the intent to call a special levy election on May 19, 1987, and to request a shorter filing time of the Resolution setting forth the special levy amount, ballot title and notice of election; and
3. Should the results of the March 31, 1987, election be favorable, then this resolution shall have no effect.
