

RESOLUTION NO. 661-R

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE  
A TWO-YEAR OPERATING SERIAL LEVY AT A SPECIAL ELECTION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE  
THAT:

1. Call for Election: An election is hereby called to be held on Tuesday, May 19, 1987, which election will be conducted between the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. at the following precincts: #5422 and #5441-Sweetbriar School, 501 SE Sweetbriar Ln; #5439-Troutdale City Hall, 104 SE Kibling St., #5442-Columbia High School, 1698 SW Cherry Park Rd. within the City of Troutdale, Multnomah County, Oregon. This measure shall be submitted to the voters of the City of Troutdale and which if approved, would authorize a two-year general fund operating serial levy beginning 1987-88.

2. Directive to City Recorder: The City Recorder shall cause a notice to be published in the Gresham Outlook on April 18, 1987, and May 2, 1987, giving notice that a measure election shall be held on May 19, 1987, to submit said measure to the legal voters of the City of Troutdale for their approval or disapproval. The full text of the measure shall appear in the notice.

3. Form of Ballot:

CAPTION: Two-Year Operating Serial Levy

QUESTION: Shall City of Troutdale levy \$ 197,772 for two years outside the tax base for operating purposes beginning 1987-88?

EXPLANATION: The purpose of this measure is to support the general operations of the City of Troutdale and to maintain services provided to the Citizens of Troutdale including full complement of police personnel, providing a police vehicle and to maintain City Hall open to Public. This measure is a 15% reduction of previous request.

It is also necessary to offset the loss of Federal revenues which supported City services and

programs. The total amount of the proposed levy is \$ 395,544 which is to be levied in equal amounts of \$ 197,772 in each of two years beginning 1987-88 and ending 1988-89.


