A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PORTLAND-TROUTDALE AIRPORT GRAHAM ROAD WATERLINE AS PART OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE'S WATER SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the Port of Portland was required to build an 8" waterline to service new industries locating in the industrial park; and

WHEREAS, the waterline project commonly known as the PTA/Graham Road Waterline located within the City of Troutdale is completed; and

WHEREAS, the various kinds of work in this improvement have been inspected as to quality, and classification by the Design Engineer and have been found to be completed in compliance with the plans and specifications; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale finds the waterline to be completed to the City's standards;

The City of Troutdale accept the PTA/Graham Road Waterline improvement project to be operated and maintained by the City of Troutdale for use by the Port.


