

RESOLUTION NO. 665-R

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING PROJECTS FOR INCLUSION IN THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SIX-YEAR HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation has an established program for the development of its Six-Year Improvement Program and inclusions thereof; and

WHEREAS, The City of Troutdale utilizes the established processes of the East Multnomah County Transportation Committee, Multnomah County and Metropolitan Service District planning processes; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Troutdale to submit its requests for consideration through this process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City does hereby recommend that the following projects be included or upgraded in the State Highway Six-Year Improvement Program:

1. Crown Point Highway (Columbia Scenic Highway) reconstruction, widening, sidewalks, illumination, drainage and other associated facilities from Halsey Street on the west to just east of Kibling Street on the east. The estimated construction costs for this project is \$290,000. This project should be funded for construction during the summer of 1988.
2. Widening and reconstruction of the Graham Road Railroad Overpass to match the geometric configuration of 257th Avenue. Estimated cost is 1.9 million dollars with construction in 1988-89 or sooner.
3. Reconstruction of Graham Road from the Columbia Scenic Highway to I-84 with the geometric cross-section compatible with the 257th Avenue extension of Graham Road. Total estimated project cost \$257,000 with construction in 1988-89 or sooner.
4. Replacement of the Sandy River Bridge construction cost estimated at 1.25 million dollars. This project would replace the existing sub-standard Sandy River Bridge with the new facility. Construction in early 1990's, design and alignment determined by 1990.

5. Other improvements to the Crown Point Highway to complete the connection with the new Sandy River Bridge and the new section ending at Kibling.


