

RESOLUTION NO. 667-R

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY OF TROUTDALE INTENT TO PROVIDE WORKER'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR VOLUNTEER PERSONNEL

Whereas, the City of Troutdale utilizes volunteer personnel to perform certain work duties; and

Whereas, the City of Troutdale desires to provide insurance protection and coverage for such volunteers; and

Whereas, Oregon State law, ORS 656.031, makes provision for workers compensation insurance coverage to be extended to volunteer personnel;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

1. The City of Troutdale declares its intent to cover volunteer personnel under workers compensation insurance coverage for the following:
  - a. Supervised work release inmates assigned from the Multnomah County Correctional Facility performing general maintenance of buildings, grounds and city vehicles.
  - b. Explorer Scouts performing traffic control and office clerical duties.
  - c. Volunteer clerical workers performing general office duties such as typing, filing, photocopying, and answering telephones.
  - d. Reserve police officers performing law enforcement duties.
  - e. Caretakers performing general care, security and maintenance at the city community park.
2. The City Finance Department is directed to file written application, as required under ORS 656.031(2), for workers compensation insurance coverage for volunteer workers with the City's insurance provider.


