A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING OPPOSITION TO THE LEGALIZATION OF MARIJUANA.

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale recognizes the negative impact of drug abuse and illegal use of drugs on all sectors of our community, and

WHEREAS, the proposed petition would legalize the cultivation and possession of small amounts of marijuana, and

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale is concerned that the legalization of any illegal drug would promote the continued growth of a drug culture in our community, and

WHEREAS, current scientific studies have shown that marijuana use does present a serious public health hazard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Troutdale strongly opposes the legalization of marijuana, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Troutdale urges all Oregonians to reject efforts to legalize this drug.
