

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A MAY 17, 1988 TAX BASE ELECTION.

WHEREAS, The Common Council deems it necessary to provide and maintain the basic level of municipal service which can only be assured by a voter approved tax base; and,

WHEREAS, The Budget Committee is in agreement that a new tax base is needed to maintain such municipal services;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

1. Call for Election: A tax base election is hereby called to be held on Tuesday, May 17, 1988 from the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. (Pacific Daylight Time). This measure shall be submitted to the voters of the City of Troutdale and which, if approved, would authorize a new tax base of \$718,370 to become effective with the 1988-89 fiscal year beginning July 1, 1988.

2. Notice of Election: The notice of election shall be in accordance with Oregon Statue, ORS 310.330 (1), which provides that the County Clerk shall give notice of the election as provided in the general election laws.

3. Form of Ballot:

CAPTION: Tax Base for City of Troutdale.

QUESTION: Shall the City of Troutdale be authorized a new tax base of \$718,370 beginning with fiscal year 1988-89?

EXPLANATION: Approval of this measure would not increase property tax revenues to City of Troutdale beyond present authorization. This measure establishes a new tax base of \$718,370 pursuant to Article XI, Section 11, Oregon Constitution, to become effective with the 1988-89 fiscal year beginning July 1, 1988. This measure would replace the tax base approved in 1980 presently at \$488,679. In 1988-89 the tax base would be \$520,598 (including additional annexed value) which is inadequate to meet city service demands. Approval of this measure will provide the same level of funding that is now in place by combining the inadequate tax base with the existing operating serial levy of \$197,772 that expires June 30, 1989.

The new tax base would permit the City to maintain General fund operations including adequate police protection, maintain neighborhood parks and recreational programs, provide for comprehensive plan maintenance and code enforcement.

- 4. Filing: The City Recorder is directed to file with the County Elections Officer a copy of this Resolution and the Notice of Measure Election.


