

RESOLUTION NO. 88 694 -R

A RESOLUTION PETITIONING THE MULTNOMAH COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR DEDICATION OF CERTAIN PORTIONS OF MULTNOMAH COUNTY FARM PROPERTY FOR PARK PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Reynolds Girls Softball League has proposed to develop a softball/soccer complex adjacent to the Columbia High School; and,

WHEREAS, Reynolds Girls Softball League has funds and volunteer time and materials totaling \$100,000 to develop the site; and,

WHEREAS, the League has made a budgetary commitment of \$20,000 per year for maintenance; and,


WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale Parks Plan [1978] has designated this area of the City as suitable, and in need of recreational facilities; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale City Council has reviewed the proposal and makes the commitment to assume future responsibility for this facility,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT The City of Troutdale petitions the Board of County Commissioners to dedicate, to the City of Troutdale, Tax Lots 35 and 8, NW 1/4 Section 35-T1N R3E, W.M. for purposes of developing a public park/recreational facility.


