RESOLUTION TO CEASE ACTIVITIES AND PARTICIPATION IN  
EAST MULTNOMAH COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT  
COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, East Multnomah County Economic Development Commission (EMCEDC) was jointly formed by the cities of Gresham, Fairview, Troutdale and Wood Village for purposes of promoting communication between cities and other public and/or private organizations for economic development purposes; and

WHEREAS, the EMCEDC has reviewed their activities and accomplishments, as well as future potential activities, and has determined their fulfillment of their initial mission; and


WHEREAS, the EMCEDC has determined that activities for future development can more effectively be accomplished by other broad based entities now in place.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT: The City of Troutdale shall cease participation in the East Multnomah County Economic Development Commission effective June 30, 1988.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT: The Intergovernmental Agreement approved September 13, 1983, is hereby terminated effective, June 30, 1988.
