A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE COLUMBIA GORGE SCENIC AREA VISITOR GATEWAY FACILITY ADJACENT TO LEWIS AND CLARK STATE PARK, AND DECLARING THE CITY'S COMMITMENT TO MAKING AVAILABLE CITY UTILITY SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Columbia Gorge National Scenic Area is adjacent to the City of Troutdale boundaries; and

WHEREAS, almost two million visitors now enter the Columbia Gorge National Scenic Area; and

WHEREAS, there are now no provisions for directing or orienting visitors to the opportunities available to them.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:


The City of Troutdale strongly supports the siting of a Gateway/Orientation Center adjacent to or in the vicinity of Lewis & Clark State Park.

ADOPTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THIS 11TH DAY OF APRIL, 1989.


